The purpose of the LEPC is to ensure the public is informed and protected through adequate preparation for possible chemical emergencies. Jefferson County's LEPC meets bi-monthly on the 3rd Wednesday, at 11:00 AM at the Rockin' A Café, 3520 West Cardinal Drive Beaumont, TX 77705-2937 (409) 842-0010. Meetings are open to anyone interested in promoting hazardous materials education and safety in our community.

In January 2004, due to a reduction in funding, Jefferson County's LEPC needed to seek alternate funding to cover operating expenses.
